Columbia Valley Community Health holding Fall Flu Shot Clinics

Monday, September 28, 2015: **Wenatchee, WA**: <u>Columbia Valley Community Health</u> (CVCH) will be holding multiple <u>flu shot clinics</u> in October and November. Individuals do not need to be a patient of CVCH to receive a vaccine during these evening and weekend clinics and most private insurance plans are accepted. CVCH offers a sliding fee scale for the uninsured.

CVCH Chelan, located at 317 E Johnson, will hold a Saturday morning clinic and four evening clinics:

- Saturday, October 3, 9am 12pm
- Monday, October 12 Thursday, October 15, 4 7pm

CVCH Wenatchee, located at 600 Orondo Ave, will hold four Saturday clinics, all 8am – 4pm, and four Wednesday clinics, all 5 – 8pm:

- Saturday, October 3
- Wednesday, October 7
- Saturday, October 17
- Wednesday, October 21
- Wednesday, November 4
- Saturday, November 7
- Wednesday, November 18
- Saturday, November 21

Walk-ins are welcome but anyone interested in scheduling an appointment should call 509.662.6000. In addition to these upcoming clinics, flu vaccines are available by appointment during <u>regular clinic hours</u> at the Wenatchee and Chelan clinics, as well as without an appointment at both <u>CVCH Express Care clinics</u>, located at 900 Eastmont Ave in East Wenatchee, and 600 Orondo Ave in Wenatchee.

The <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u> recommends that everyone receive a flu vaccine to protect against the threat of a seasonal influenza outbreak. Those most at risk for developing flu-related complications include children between the ages of two and five years old, adults 65 years and older and pregnant women.
