Columbia Valley Community Health has partnered with the University of Washington to offer a rural training track opportunity for physicians interested in practicing full-spectrum family medicine. We are an ACGME-accredited residency and accept applications through ERAS.

Program Overview

- This is a 1-2 rural training track program committed to academic excellence and preparing physicians to meet the demands of rural practice.
- Residents will spend one year in Seattle where they will get intense inpatient and emergency medicine training. They will then move to Chelan where they will spend the final two years of their training integrated into the rural site.
